## STARTING MAY 1, 2017

We regret to inform you that our current online payment processor has notified us that it will be going out of business as of April 30<sup>th</sup>. We are very excited to announce that we have partnered with Point and Pay LLC, who will be launching our ALL NEW online payment portal starting May 1, 2017. The new portal will provide an easy and convenient billing and payment experience for our customers. However, due to the short notice to launch the new portal, there will be phases as to when the new features will be available. With the transition to the new portal, customers will need to know the following important information:

- If you have a current online registered account at <u>www.diablowater.org</u> your logins and auto-payments will not be transferred from the previous payment portal. We apologize in advance for this inconvenience.
- The first time you visit the new payment portal starting May 1<sup>st</sup>, you will need to re-register and create a new account.
- Everyone will receive a paper bill in the month of May. If there have been any changes to your mailing address, please call the office to update this in our system 925-625-3798, then press 0.
