Senate Bill 998 Disconnection of Water Service Appeal

Per California Senate Bill 998 (Dodd - 2018) a water supplier may not shut off residential water service if the following three items are provided:

- (1) I am the primary care provider for \_\_\_\_\_ and certify under penalty of perjury, that discontinuation of residential water service will be life threatening to or will pose a serious threat to the health and safety of, a resident of the premises where residential service is provided.

- (3) \_\_\_\_\_ Initial indicating that you are willing to enter into an amortization agreement (not to exceed 12 months).
