

Legal Right to Have Water-Wise Landscaping

According to California Civil Code Section 4735:

• A homeowner's association (HOA) may not prohibit a homeowner from installing a water-wise landscape.

• An HOA may apply landscaping rules if they conform with the law.

• During times of drought emergency, an HOA may not impose a fine or assessment against a homeowner for reducing or eliminating the watering of vegetation or lawns, except in cases where a homeowner receives recycled water, but fails to use it for landscaping irrigation.
